Reports/Presentations

Budget

Juan Hernandez, Business Manager, reported total September enrollment was 922.47 including ALE. This year TK students have been excluded from basic enrollment figures. Their funding is calculated based on the Average Annual Full-Time Equivalent (AAFTE) enrollment. Running Start students will be included in the October count.

Mr. Hernandez stated in the month of September, 8% of the fiscal year has elapsed. Revenues are at \$1,102,113 of the annual budget. This is within expectations. The Food Service application has been completed and submitted.

Mr. Hernadez gave an overview of the various funds listed below and informed the board the Year-End Report will be submitted for review to the ESD on October 25th.

Levy Discussion

Juan Hernandez, Business Manager, presented to the board different scenarios for the upcoming EP & O Replacement Levy. Mr. Hernandez is proposing scenario two with an estimated fix levy rate of 2.25 per \$1,000 for the four-year levy range years of 2025 through 2028. This option is estimated to collect \$1,546,154 (2024-2025), \$1,631,675 (2025-2026), \$1,696.942 (2026-2027), and \$1,764,820 (2027-2028) for those school years.

Special Education

Kayla Johanson, Special Education Director, shared Emily Bushouse from the ESD came to work with the Paraprofessionals to talk to them about student behaviors. The Federal Special Education Grant was approved. The Special Education Department is also working on federal count. Former Special education students were contacted to answer post-graduation surveys as required by grants.

Elementary 3rd-5th

Garrett Grant, 3rd-5th Elementary Principal, has been focusing on data to drive interventions supports and will continuing to review assessment the last Monday of every month.

Mr. Grant announced the recent hire from Ameri-Corp Maria Garcia. Ameri Corp is a program that offers the school the possibility of having a person on site to support the elementary staff with paraprofessional duties at no cost to the school.

Mr. Grant stated Picture Day was a success and he thanked Peggy Rice for her help.

High School

Todd Phillips, High School Principal, announced Student Led Conferences are coming up this week. This year's seniors were given the option to opt out of their student lead conference if they were all caught up, but this idea led to a lot of confusion and distress with parents and students. Leaving Mr. Phillips with the conclusion of not offering this option in the future.

Mr. Phillips gave a shout out to his staff for doing an amazing job! He has encouraged them to observe each other and has allowed them to visit other schools to make observations to gain skills and better their teaching strategies. He believes these ideas will help new teachers grow and become better teachers.

Middle School

Greg Austin, MS Principal, stated he is almost done with his first round of observations. He was please to see most teachers engaging with students and was able to see targets and objectives posted on the classroom walls.

Mr. Austin, Athletic Director, shared Fall Post Season updates:

Mrs. Blackburn gave an update on the construction regarding the Coop Transportation Facility. The Harkins house will be demolished soon. It is expected that the High School should be finalized by the end of next week.
